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The Health Ethics Trust has offered compliance professional certification (Certified Compliance Professional: CCP) since the Trust's inception in 1995. The Council itself has certified compliance professionals since 1988, including healthcare compliance professionals. No organization has trained more working healthcare compliance professionals. The goal of the Trust's certification program is to promote professionalism and competence throughout the healthcare compliance community.

The CCE certification is appropriate for compliance professionals who serve in compliance leadership roles such as chief compliance officer of an organization or a division of an organizations. There is no question that there are different levels of accomplishment among compliance professionals and that the highest levels deserve special recognition.

The CCE process in overseen by the Education Committee of the Council of Ethical Organizations. This is an independent and voluntary committee of experienced compliance professionals from around the country. Members of this committee oversee changes to HET certification criteria as well as reviewing applications for HET certification.

Compliance professionals who wish to complete the certification process must earn a total of 170 points in the identified categories within a three-year period to qualify.
